



En Pointe Theatre Arts Studio Rules

Please ensure all rules are followed by both dancers, dance families and members of staff:

- Treat each other with respect at all times. Negativity and disrespectful behaviour will not be tolerated.
- Inappropriate language is not permitted, and students caught utilising inappropriate language will be challenged
- Substance misuse, including smoking, drugs, and alcohol, is not permitted by students, family members or members of staff at any time
- Stair rails must not be utilised as slides
- No climbing down in between stair panels and rails
- No doing gymnastics during classes (carwheels, handstands, walkovers etc) unless it is part of the lesson i.e.in contemporary or modern
- Students must not disrupt classes while waiting for their own class by waving through windows and entering the studio without an acceptable reason
- Dancers should attend classes in correct uniform in relation to their genre and level of study
- Hair should be tied off the face and neck and in a ballet bun or cross-over braids for ballet
- Outdoor shoes may not be worn into the studio
- No jewellery, including watches, is permitted to be worn during class; however, small stud earrings may be worn
- Mobile phones must be switched off or on silent and left in dancers' bags in the waiting area.
- No eating or chewing gum in the studio during class
- All litter must be placed into bins provided

- Studio and waiting area must be left as found
- Students must ask permission prior to leaving the studio during class time
- Students must be promptly collected following their last class.
